Responsibilities and Job Duties

The Attraction Maintenance Technician is a multi-craft position that requires a working knowledge of mechanical, electrical, control, and hydraulic systems. This position is responsible for completing routine maintenance, daily startup and inspections, and emergency and routine maintenance support to the ongoing operation of the Beam attraction. Attraction Maintenance Technicians will work independently and as part of a team, tasks include:

- Conduct regular inspections of equipment and systems to identify potential issues and ensure proper functioning
- Perform routine maintenance tasks, including troubleshooting and repairing mechanical, electrical, and hydraulic systems
- Respond to service calls in a timely manner
- Read basic mechanical assembly drawings and manuals
- Maintain accurate records of maintenance activities according to company procedures
- Maintain a safe working environment for yourself and the team by keeping all work spaces clean and secure
- Complete and maintain OSHA 30 general industry certification, demonstrate safe work practices and safety leadership at all times
- Work in a professional and courteous manner with the attraction Operations team
- Provide excellent customer service to guests when in a guest facing area
- Perform all other duties as instructed by RMI supervision and management

Experience and Qualifications

- Strong mechanical knowledge and experience in troubleshooting and repairing equipment
- Proficiency in reading and interpreting schematics, blueprints, and technical manuals
- Electrical knowledge and experience working with electrical systems, including wiring, motors, and control panels, and logic controllers.
- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision while also being a team player
- Previous experience supervising or leading a team is a plus
- Excellent problem-solving skills and the ability to think critically to diagnose issues accurately
